Introduction To The Concealed Handgun

COURSE GOAL

To teach the basic knowledge, skills, and attitude necessary to carry a concealed handgun for personal protection.

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This course uses the NRA CCW curriculum, handouts, hands on demonstrations, practical safe gun handling, and Range Time to safely learn the skills and attitude to be able to apply for the CHP.

- Federal and state laws pertaining to the lawful purchase, ownership, transportation, use, and possession of firearms - Handout

- Requirements for reporting lost or stolen firearms as described in C.R.S. 18-12-113 -Handout
- ❖ Requirements for secure firearms storage as described in C.R.S. 18-12-114 Handout
- ❖ State laws pertaining to the use of deadly force for self-defense. Handout
- ❖ Instruction on any other state law enacted within 5 years before the class that pertains to the purchase, ownership, transportation, use, and possession of firearms Handout
- Best practices to ensure concealed handgun permit holders safely interact with law enforcement personnel who are responding to an emergency - NRA CCW
- Instruction regarding techniques for avoiding a criminal attack and how to manage a violent confrontation, including conflict resolution and judgmental use of lethal force – NRA CCW

Elements Required for Certificate:

- Students must complete a live-fire exercise on a range, discharging at least 50 rounds with a minimum 70% accuracy score NRA CCW Course of Fire
- ❖ Students must complete a written Concealed Handgun Competency exam which tests a student's knowledge of the subjects described in C.R.S 18-12-202.5 (3)(a) to (3)(f), with a minimum score of 80%. NRA CCW Exam and additional questions relating to specified Colorado Revised Statues.
